



Siem Reap-Kratie-Phnom Penh 6 Days / 5 Nights program – RV Tourn Tiou II ~ August / September ~

Day 1 Siem Reap – Chnok Tru

- 07:00** Meet FCC hotel. Transfer to pier.
Local boats are coming along the RV Tourn Tiou II and picking passengers for the visit of the biggest floating village on the Tonlé Sap River
- 08:30** Departure for Chnok Tru. Enjoy the Tonlé Sap Lake.
- 12:00** Lunch on board
- 16:00** Arrival in Chnok Tru. Visit the largest floating village on the Tonle Sap River.
- 17:30** Leave Chnok Tru to Kampong Chnang. Dinner on board.

Day 2 Kampong Chnang – Kampong Tralach

- 07:00** Breakfast on the way to Kampong Chnang.
- 09:00** Arrival at Kampong Chnang. Visit the village and its environment.
Located some 90 kilometers from Phnom Penh, the town of Kampong Chnang is one of the largest fishing ports on the Tonlé Sap. Fish farming is also widely practiced in the area. The area is famous for its pottery ware, unchanged in style for centuries, which is produced in sufficient quantities to supply the entire country? And not to be overlooked are the products of the Thnot tree (sugar palm – a real national symbol) that abounds in the area: a mellow tasting, caramel-colored sugar sold in large cakes and palm wine.
- 12:00** Lunch, Leave for Kampong Tralach.
- 16:00** Arrival in Kampong Tralach.
Visit of its wonderful Vihara belonging to Wat Kampong Tralach Leu pagoda. To get to it, we cross Kampong Tralach Krom village along a small road perpendicular to the river, crossing some gorgeous stretches of emerald rice paddy as we leave the river behind.
The Vihara dates back to early last century. It was probably built on an older site, as indicated by the latérite foundations, and is home to some outstanding mural paintings. These, however, are starting to suffer from weathering. They remain one of the last survivors of cultural destruction that continues unabated due to widespread indifference.
Standing by itself in the middle of rice fields, it is a modest pagoda that receives very few visitors. Its isolation may well be its undoing, as was the case for Wat Tani Pagoda in the province of Kampot.
- 18:00** Departure for Phum Thmei
- 19:00** Dinner and overnight on boat on the way to Phum Thmei.
- 22:30** Overnight on board at anchor

Day 3 Phum Thmei – Kampong Cham

- 06:00** Departure for Phum Thmei
- 07:45** Breakfast during navigation.
- 10:00** Discussion about Cambodia with your local guide
- 12:00** Lunch on board
- 15:30** Arrival to Phum Thmei
Literally known as the “new village”, the passengers can get an insight into Cambodian life, a nice way to have a break after their Phnom Penh “adventure”. First village to be visited on the Mekong; a local ferry will come to pick them up and transfer them to shore.
- 17:00** Departure for Kampong Cham
- 19:00** Dinner on board
- 21:00** Arrival to Kampong Cham. Overnight on board



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Day 4 **Kampong Cham**

- 08:00** Passengers disembark for the visit of Kampong Cham.
The passengers leave for a long tour to the Angkorian temple of Nokor Bachey then head to the ruins of a pagoda on the hill Phnom Pros, which translation would be: "the man's hill", in front of Phnom Srey ("the woman's hill").
- 12:00** Departure for Kratie and lunch on the way.
- 16:00** Cooking lesson with our Chief, as he unravels the key secrets of Cambodia's finest, traditional dishes.
- 19:00** Dinner while sailing.
- 22:00** Overnight at anchor on the way to Kratie.

Day 5 **Kratie**

- 06:00** Departure for Kratie.
- 07:30** Breakfast while sailing.
- 10:00** Documentary about the natural resources of Cambodia.
- 12:00** Lunch on board.
- 13:00** Arrival in Kratie.
- 14:00** Visit of Kratie.
City tour of Kratie, visit of the pagoda of Wat Roka Kandal then the passengers will try to catch a picture of the unique fresh water Irrawaddy dolphins. Finally they will end this tropical day with a swim in the Mekong
- 18:00** Departure to Wat Hanchey
- 22:00** Overnight at anchor on the way to Wat Hanchey

Day 6 **Wat Hanchey – Phnom Penh**

- 05:30** Departure for Wat Hanchey.
- 07:00** Breakfast.
- 08:30** Arrival to Wat Hanchey and visit pre-Angkorian temple on the hill.
- 10:00** Departure for Phnom Penh.
- 12:30** Lunch on the way
Afternoon of navigation, perfect time for leisure, lecture and discussion about Cambodia with your local guide.

- 21:00** Arrival at Phnom Penh.



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
